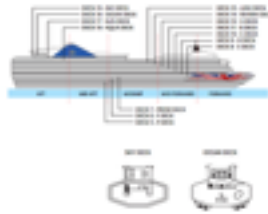


Here are some of the crew members of a large cruise ship. They are standing on one of the 14 decks
